Highways Serving Port	State Road 528 provides a direct route west; Interstate 95 offers a direct north/south route.
Railways Serving Port	Florida East Coast Railroad is located 10 miles from Port Canaveral.
# of Freight Forwarders Serving Area	4 in Port; over 30 in Orlando.
# of Import/Export Brokers Serving Area	2 in Port; over 30 in Orlando.
# of International Courier Firms Serving Area	All major companies are badged to pick-up and drop-off in Port Canaveral.
